Dear Member,

Welcome to the election process for the positions on the Saskatchewan College of Psychologists, which become vacant in 2004. The Nominating Committee (Sandy Gardiner, SEPA rep; Fern Stockdale Winder, SPA rep; a Public Rep yet to be named and Diane Stover, PSS rep) is seeking nominations for the Executive Council. Because some of the positions filled last year were for a two year term, we are only seeking nominations for the following positions:

President-Elect (2 years – 1 year President-Elect and 1 year President)
Secretary (2 years)
2 Members at Large (2 year terms)

Descriptions of each position are attached. In order to be eligible for Council, a member must be a full-practising member residing in Saskatchewan. A candidate may only run for one position.

To nominate a member for a position, begin by discussing the nomination with the member. If they are agreeable, complete the enclosed nomination form, the biographical information (see below), and request the nominee to sign the attached consent form. You may make more than one nomination. If you require additional nomination forms, they are available from the SCP office, or from the website (www.skcp.ca). **Nominations must be received, in writing, on or before January 27, 2004.**

In order to assist members in voting, we are requesting that each nominee provide us with biographical information. This information will be distributed with the ballots, and will also be posted on the SCP website. We would request that you limit the description to approximately 250 words. Point form is preferred.

In your biographical summary, we would suggest including information in the following areas:

1. Educational Background
2. Work Experience (Place of Employment, Areas of Expertise, Research)
3. Professional Memberships
4. Committee Experience
5. Volunteer Work
6. Other Relevant Information
7. Why do you want to be on Council?
8. What do you feel you can contribute?

In the distributed biographical summary we will include your name, the position you are running for, your town or city of residence, and the information that you provide.

We will also require scrutineers for the election. Non-practising members and non-members are eligible to act as scrutineers. If you know of someone who might be interested in serving in this capacity, please inform the SCP office.

Thank you for your consideration of this request. We look forward to receiving your nominations.
