Educational and Work Experience

I graduated with a Doctor of Philosophy in Clinical Psychology at the University of Regina (CPA Accredited) in 2007 and became fully registered with the SCP in 2009. I completed a one-year full-time pre-doctoral residency at the Department of Clinical Health Psychology, Faculty of Medicine, University of Manitoba (APA and CPA accredited). I have published in a number of peer-reviewed journals and co-authored multiple book chapters in the areas of ethics and pain assessment. I have also taught undergraduate level courses at the University of Regina.

I have been employed since 2006 at the Children's Program, Wascana Rehabilitation Centre, Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region (RQHR) and also have a small private practice. Children's Program is a paediatric out-patient physical rehabilitation centre that supports families, health professional and community caregivers to promote the optimal development of children with physical, neurological and/or developmental disabilities. Within this setting I provide developmental, diagnostic, and behavioural assessments for children as well as best-practice intervention. I work within a multi-disciplinary team of allied health professionals and provide consultation to these members. I have supervised a number of doctoral level psychology students as well as students completing a pre-doctoral internship at RQHR.
