1.0 Further discussion and planning in respect to the request from the Professional Conduct Committee to have public representation on the Committee was reviewed. Due to legislation precluding public representatives from Council serving on the Professional Conduct Committee, it was decided that the College will employ a public representative for the Committee.

2.0 Information was received in respect to the annual ASPPB meeting from October 17-21, 2018 that was held in Salt Lake City, Utah. Information was provided regarding the development of the Enhanced EPPP, credential evaluation, and regulatory issues from the larger perspective of Canadian and United States member bodies of ASPPB.

3.0 Implications for Psychologists in respect to recent federal legislation regarding Cannabis use were discussed. Specifically, impairment as per the Canadian Code of Ethics for Psychologists was discussed. An advisory will be forthcoming.

4.0 Discussion occurred about the responses received to the recent circulation of the advisory and letter of "Use of Title, Title Format and Abbreviation".

5.0 The 2019 Draft Budget was received and discussed. Potential for a deficit was identified and discussed.

6.0 As there has been an increase of foreign trained applicants to the College, discussion occurred regarding the current credential services used and the
