1.0 President provided a brief orientation for incoming Executive Council members. Discussed the responsibilities of each role on the Council, and the importance of members familiarizing themselves with existing College advisories, policies and administrative bylaws.

2.0 Discussed setting up an information session on the EPPP-Part 2 (*Skills*), to be held in the fall and attended by members of Council, and the Oral Exam and Registration Committees.

3.0 Registrar provided an update on judicial reviews and appeals currently in process. Council approved Vilness and Helmsing discipline decisions to be posted to the website.

4.0 Approved the appointment of new legal representation for the Professional Conduct Committee.

5.0 Discussed the differences in what academic requirements are accepted by different regulatory bodies in Canada, and the challenges these different standards present when it comes to Canada Free Trade Agreement (CFTA) and Time-Limited Licensure (TLL) applications.

6.0 Task Force Chair provided an update on the first meeting of the Truth and Reconciliation Task Force, which was held on June 1, 2021.
