1.0 Registrar provided an update on items relating to risk governance.

2.0 Council reviewed proposed changes to the current regulatory bylaws.

3.0 Council held a discussion around telepsychology services.

4.0 Council passed a motion to remove the advisories which are currently available to the membership on the College website, as the information presented in some advisories is outdated/no longer accurate. Frequently asked questions will instead be addressed in newsletters to the membership.

5.0 Council held a discussion around recognized supervised settings and job role and functions for provisional members. Council agreed that a provisional member's title should not be the deciding factor as to whether that setting is approved, but that decisions should be based on the "psychological" services provided, as defined in the goals and objectives document of the supervision plan, that the provisional psychologist plans to perform under supervision.

6.0 The amended terms of reference for the Truth and Reconciliation Task Force were presented, and a motion to approve the new terms of reference was passed.
