15 1.0 Registrar provided an update on items relating to risk governance.

17 2.0 Council discussed the potential future implementation of the EPPP – Part 2 (Skills) in
18 Saskatchewan.
19
20 3.0 Registrar advised that provisional members are being added to the Register without
21 an approved Supervision Plan by the Registration Committee, in contravention of
22 regulatory bylaws ss 11(1). Council agreed that Supervision Plans must be approved
23 by the College prior to applicants being accepted for provisional membership.

25 4.0 Discussion was held around the requirements for secondary supervisors. Policy 3.15
26 (Supervision for Licensure) will be amended to reflect that all supervisors of
27 provisional members must hold Full Practise licensure for a minimum of one year, be
28 in good standing, and not currently under formal disciplinary action.

30 5.0 Deborah Parker-Loewen provided an update on the Truth and Reconciliation Task
31 Force. Council approved a pre-AGM workshop focused on the history of Indigenous
32 healthcare in Saskatchewan, and how it has affected psychology services provided to
33 Indigenous persons within the province. This addresses one of the TRC Calls to Action
34 to provide cultural competency training for all health-care professionals.
