## Highlights of October 22, 2022 Council Meeting

- Location:** Electronic Platform, Zoom 10:03 a.m. – 1:22 p.m.

- 1.0 Discussion was held on the priorities that need to be addressed before a Strategic Planning session could be scheduled. The most urgent priorities were identified as: updating policies and procedures to align with legislation; redesigning forms; developing guidelines for declared areas of competency; training for discipline committee members; and training for supervisors of provisional members.
- 2.0 Council passed a motion for the Larrea discipline decision to be posted to the website.
- 3.0 Terms of reference were approved for the newly formed Competency Declaration Review Committee.
- 4.0 A motion was passed for John Lagimodiere to attend a future Council meeting to provide a presentation on Aboriginal Awareness.
- 5.0 Council discussed the requirement for direct supervision in ss. 13(4) of the regulatory bylaws. A legal opinion was received, and this clause was interpreted to mean that a supervisor who possesses their APE must be present when a diagnosis is communicated by a provisional psychologist or pre- or post-doctoral intern. Council agreed with the legal opinion.
- 6.0 The Truth and Reconciliation Commission Ad Hoc Committee co-chairs, Dr. Holly Graham and Dr. Deborah Parker-Loewen, presented a draft report including their recommendations.
