1. Complete the 2022 Nomination form.
2. Obtain written consent of your nominee on the form.
3. In conjunction with the nominee, submit the nomination form with the Biographical information.

SCP members with Full Practice designation residing in Saskatchewan are eligible to fill positions on the Council. A Full Practice member may only let their name stand for one position. A SCP member is eligible to nominate one or more individuals for positions on the Council.

Information on nominees will be posted on the SCP website on or before **March 4, 2022**, and ballots and biographical summaries of all nominees will be mailed to all practicing SCP members. In the event that no nomination is received for a position, the Council is charged under **Bylaw 19(3)** with the responsibility of making a suitable appointment to the position.
