- 14 1.0 The term of the current senate representative at the University of Saskatchewan will be  
15 expiring in June 2023. Council requested that a notice of interest be emailed to full  
16 practicing members of the College regarding this appointment.

- 18 2.0 Council members were invited to attend an information session on Bill 120 which, if  
19 proclaimed, could lead to changes related to complaints, investigation, and discipline for  
20 Saskatchewan regulators. Members of the Professional Conduct Committee, Discipline  
21 Committee, and College staff will be attending this session.

- 23 3.0 Discussion regarding provisional members and private practice settings continued. A legal  
24 opinion was received which offered further guidance as to how the College can regulate  
25 this issue while being mindful of provisional members working in small education, mental  
26 health settings, or isolated communities.

- 28 4.0 The Registrar and President-Elect were approved to attend the ACPRO meeting in  
29 Toronto, ON, from June 22 – 24, 2023.

- 31 5.0 Council was informed that ASPPB will require jurisdictions which are using the EPPP – Part  
32 1 (Knowledge) to implement the EPPP – Part 2 (Skills) by January 1, 2026. If this change is  
33 implemented, Council will need to determine a process for addressing the APE and an  
34 ethics/jurisprudence component of the examination.
