16 1.0 A new Member-at-Large and Public Representative were welcomed to Council.

18 2.0 Council considered the person/persons who may fill the role of Elder/Knowledge Keeper
19 on the TRC Ad Hoc Implementation Committee. Ideally, this individual will have a
20 background in health or mental health, and will be able to assist the Committee in
21 supporting the regulatory work of the College by recommending next steps that can be
22 taken to address items in the TRC Ad Hoc Committee report.

24 3.0 Council reviewed a notice of appeal that had been submitted for their consideration. A
25 motion was passed to set a date to hear this appeal. As part of this discussion, a second
26 motion was passed for an amendment be made to the regulatory bylaws to grant the
27 College flexibility in such situations which involve extenuating circumstances.

29 4.0 Council passed a motion for the President to attend the upcoming ASPPB meeting in
30 Cleveland, OH from September 27 – October 1, 2023.

32 5.0 During the April 22, 2023 meeting, it was brought to Council’s attention that members
33 are not legislatively required to carry liability insurance. A request was put forward for
34 this to be included in the regulatory bylaws so that members would be required to carry
35 liability insurance as part of their registration with the College.
