SCP Council Candidate Biographical Guidelines

When SCP members are asked to vote, choosing between candidates who may offer the best service in a given position on the Council, it can be especially helpful to have a summative statement outlining what that individual can bring to the position. This statement can be written either by the nominee or the member making the nomination. To provide a generally consistent basis for voting SCP members to gain a reasonable knowledge of candidates, each is asked to restrict their description to no more than 300 words. Statements of greater length will be edited by the Nominations Committee or by a SCP staff member. The brevity of these biographical statements will allow them to be combined for sending out with the ballots. These sketches may also be posted on the SCP website.

The biographical summary will hopefully include some or all of the following highlights and may be written in point form:

1. Educational Background
2. Work Experience (e.g. place of Employment, Areas of Expertise, Research)
3. Committee Experience (e.g. related volunteer work)
4. Other Relevant Information, (e.g. Professional Memberships)
5. Why may you want to be on Council?
6. What do you feel you can contribute?

Any biographical summary distributed will include a nominee's name, the position to be elected to, the member's town or city of residence, and the description that provided.

All biographical information must be submitted to the SCP office on or before **the final date for nominations**. E-mail materials are appreciated, but faxes and paper copies are also certainly acceptable. Please make certain that all biographical information is submitted on or before the deadline, at the following address:
