16 1.0 Ongoing discussions regarding the complaints and discipline processes occurred.
17 The process was discussed and in particular how to address areas where there
18 are some concerns (e.g., scheduling hearings, costs associated with the process).
19 A policy was approved to take legal action in regard to Discipline Order costs and
20 fines which have not been paid.

22 2.0 Review and discussions occurred regarding a variety of factors and implications
23 of health professions regulation, with emphasis on protection of the public.

25 3.0 Dr. Tim Claypool has been approved as the SCP’s representative on the U of S
