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Memorandum of Understanding between

Saskatchewan College of Psychologists (SCP) and Psychological Association of Manitoba (PAM)

for telepsychology services delivered to psychologists, their immediate family members and / or staff members of the above-named provincial regulatory bodies and professional associations

IMPORTANT – Practicing within the bounds of this agreement does not mean that one is registered (i.e., a member) with the Saskatchewan College of Psychologists. This MOU falls under section 15 – Temporary License of the Saskatchewan Regulatory Bylaws.

B. TERMS OF SCP – PAM MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. This MOU permits eligible registered psychologists / psychological associates whose “home jurisdiction” is Manitoba to provide telepsychology services to the following parties from the “receiving jurisdiction” of Saskatchewan ***only***: psychologists registered with the Saskatchewan College of Psychologists, and / or their immediate family members (i.e., spouses, partners, children, stepchildren, adopted children), and staff members of the Saskatchewan College of Psychologists and the Psychology Association of Saskatchewan.
2. This agreement is only open to members who are in “good standing” and who are licensed for full (independent) practice with the Psychological Association of Manitoba.
3. Services are to be delivered by ***telepsychology only***; this agreement does not entitle the psychologist / psychological associate to claim registration or to provide in-person services in Saskatchewan.
4. Registered psychologists / psychological associates who wish to provide services under this agreement are responsible to submit a completed form prior to their first anticipated appointment with a client in the receiving jurisdiction, and are responsible to re-submit completed forms at the ***start of each calendar year*** as appropriate.
5. Complaints related to services provided under this MOU will be forwarded to the Psychological Association of Manitoba.
6. The home jurisdiction will bear all costs and liabilities associated with investigating and adjudicating complaints against the telepsychology practice of its registrants.
7. This MOU was signed on May 15, 2023, and ***will remain in effect until May 15, 2025***. The parties will convene prior to the expiry of this term to discuss the possible extension of the agreement.
8. This agreement may be cancelled at any time by any party with two weeks written notice; however, cancellation will not affect those who are currently providing services to clients in Saskatchewan. No new clients may be assumed if the agreement is cancelled.
