- 1.0 A revision of the Advisory “Use of Title, Title Format and Abbreviation” was considered and approved for posting.2.0 A draft Letter to Employers regarding the proper use of title was approved for distribution.
- 2.0 Approval was given for the posting of the Discipline Committee decision pertaining to Dr. Chartier.
- 3.0 Request from the Professional Conduct Committee to have public representation on the Committee was received and approved.
- 4.0 Discussion regarding the ongoing development of the Enhanced EPPP (knowledge and skills assessment). The exam is scheduled for voluntary implementation as of January 1, 2020. The EC is in support of the Enhanced exam.
