[**Note:** Secondary supervisors must sign off on the final page of a provisional members' supervised practice log if they provided any direct supervision in the hours covered by that log. The primary supervisor is expected to provide the majority of supervision, and is ultimately responsible for overseeing the supervisee's practice while they are provisionally registered. Secondary supervisors may only offer supervision which has been delegated to them by the primary supervisor.

Secondary supervisors can either co-sign the midpoint and final MRA Rating Form completed by the primary supervisor (if they agree with the scores/feedback provided), or may submit a separate MRA Rating Form with their own scores/comments.

Secondary supervisors who have been delegated responsibility to supervise an area of competency/client population not claimed by the supervisee's primary supervisor are required to sign off on each page of the supervisee's practice log, as well as sign and date the final page. They should also submit a separate MRA Rating Form evaluating the supervisee's practice in the area they have been delegated responsibility for supervising.

Back-up/emergency supervisors do not need to sign off on practice logs or MRA Rating Forms. Hours of supervision provided by any parties other than approved primary and secondary supervisors cannot be counted towards the 1,500-hr supervised practice requirement.]
